#### **Board of Directors Overview**

At One Bistro, our Board Members hold an important role in the health and growth of the overall organization. It is crucial that the Board of Directors have a sense of ownership in our organization and community café model by being the first to volunteer, donate, garner support, and provide advisement.

By acting as a safety net for our mission, the Board not only provides careful watch over our organizational integrity through financial accountability, but also keeps sight of One Bistro's constituency (those we serve in our community, those who volunteer, and those who give), and what they need us to do. In many cases, the Board not only cares about the constituency, but our Board Members come from the constituency, know the constituency, and are the constituency.

We seek Board Members with a wide range of skills and expertise, and provide a place for our members to give back to the community using their unique gifts and talents.

Typically, the Board of Directors at One Bistro meet monthly in the evening.

## **Board Member Responsibilities**

Individual Board Member Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Regular attendance at board and committee meetings.
- Attend or volunteer at as many one bistro special events as possible.
- Represent One Bistro to stakeholders acting as an ambassador on behalf of the organization.
- Serve as a trusted advisor to the Director with regards to developing and implementing One Bistro's strategic plan.
- Review agenda and supporting materials prior to board meetings.
- Approve One Bistro's monthly financials, annual budget, audit reports, and material business decisions; being informed of, and meeting all, legal and fiduciary responsibilities.
- Responsible for annual performance evaluation of the Director.
- Assist with fundraising by either personal financial giving or securing outside financial support.
- Assist the Director and Board President in identifying and recruiting other Board Members.
- Serve on committees or task forces and taking on special assignments.
- Hold a Board position for a minimum of a one-year term with a maximum of a threeyear term, and until a successor is elected and qualified.

### **Board Member Recruitment Process**

- 1. Board Member candidates meet with the Board Chair and/or the Director, and are given an overview of our organization and its mission, and the board responsibilities and expectations.
- 2. Once candidates indicate interest in being a part of the Board, their resumes and applications are sent to the existing members for review, comments, and voting.
- 3. Once approved, the Board Chair meets with the candidate to discuss next steps.
- 4. Candidate will begin to attend meetings.
